A vintage Moroccan Beni M'Tir featuring large scale elongated lozenges that appear stretched over the field. The motif network is filled with an array of Berber symbology, including 8-pointed stars, ladders, diamonds, and cross forms. The abrashed crimson red ground abruptly shifts to magenta and plum, lending depth and a striking contrast to the pattern in orange, violet, celadon, and charcoal. 100% wool.
