This Azilal exhibits a broken lozenge network with its own personality and sense of movement. A primarily neutral palette of ivory and dark brown wool has subtle light brown variations running through it. Colored cotton fibers punctuate the composition, knotted in black, burgundy, turquoise, and pale yellow, with small hints of cobalt blue, red, and fluorescent green woven on a cotton warp. Excellent quality wool.
