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An understated and sophisticated Azilal with an emphasis on texture rather than pattern. Deceivingly minimal when viewed at a distance, but upon closer look, the more complex structure and colors becomes apparent. Color comes into play through cotton knots in navy, yellow, red, green, and violet on an ivory and dark brown wool field. Additional hints of multicolor in the woven weft peek through the pile. Cotton warp and fringe.
