Full of character with its asymmetry and unusual proportions, this vintage Beni Ouarain carpet exemplifies the spirit of handcraft found in Berber arts. The large feminine central lozenge motifs are flanked by an offset male branch forming a moment of protection. Finished with a flatware band at one end. Knotted in dark brown and sable wool on a subtle ivory ground. Note the unusual square proportions. 100% wool.
