> A playful piece from the Aït Bou Ichaouen (Talsint), this vintage Moroccan carpet displays a field of hamsa (#hashtag) motifs, that while look randomly placed, actually form lozenge patterns upon a second inspection. The multicolored forms are knotted in bright pink, purple and celadon green, contrasting over a ground of sable grey. Finished with banded flat weave at each end with a dense medium pile. 100% wool.
