This Azilal has an unusual composition of horizontal lozenge rows connected by linear elements, with both solid and open motifs. The heathered ivory and sunny yellow/orange field is knotted in wool pile, as are hints of cobalt blue and dark brown. Accent colors in loden green, pale grey, magenta, and some dark brown areas are knotted in cotton fibers, typical of many Azilals.
