A network of triangles fills the field of this vintage Moroccan Chiadma carpet, a female symbol of prosperity and fullness. Male vertical linear protection motifs extend through the center and side borders. The color palette of deep magenta, orange, melange grey, and ivory combined with the carpet's bold geometry lends a very modern feel to the piece. Knotted in wool with some cotton pile present on a cotton warp.
