This colorful Boucherouite balances male/female symbolism, with a checkerboard pattern dispersed between a central vertical lozenge chain and side borders. Wool pile is knotted in a palette of pale apricot, mustard yellow, seafoam green, and violet on a wool warp with multicolor cotton weft. A time faded patina adds to the character of the piece.
