An exceptional vintage Moroccan Azilal with a lozenge network that progresses from a more regular to organic formation, dotted with male cross and female fertility motifs. Asymmetrical side protection borders contain both male and female abstract symbolism, including a checkerboard motif not typically found in carpets from this tribe. Knotted in an unusual palette of faded turquoise, orange, dark brown, periwinkle, and yellow on an ivory ground. A fine, lustrous wool pile knotted on a cotton warp.
