This wonderful multicolored Chiadma exhibits an overall lozenge network organized in horizontal bands capped with a chessboard pattern at the top. The lozenges are divided by cross motifs forming quadrants, adding to the geometric visual interest of the piece. Small chains of lozenges form partial side borders along both selvedges. Knotted in a palette of red, pink, magenta, periwinkle, grass green, celadon, orange, khaki, and dark brown on a tonal grey warp. 100% wool.
