A colorful vintage Beni M'Guild example with a time faded patina. The abrashed faded magenta ground is a dense pile with a pattern knotted in orange, pink, indigo, faded violet and ivory. The ground lozenge network is divided into sections by vertical bands of triangle forms. Within the columns, the triangles form abstract lozenges, representing the female presence. The bottom of the pieces is finished with a horizontal branch motif. Minor fringe loss, 100% wool.
