With a strong emphasis on color and geometry, this more recent Boujad carpet offers its own unique interpretation of Berber symbolism. Horizontal bands of open and filed lozenges are bordered by vertical zig zag motifs, finished with a multicolor chessboard motif at one end. The abrashed field of deep reds and browns creates a foundation for the vibrant pattern. Woven in 100% wool.
