> An unusual find, this striking Boujad hanbel (flat weave) is a more refined example than the traditional monochromatic pieces commonly found from this tribe. Horizontal bands of varying thicknesses in faded orange, reds, grass green and charcoal are met by substantial sawtooth borders along both selvedges. 100% wool.
