A very unique vintage Moroccan Aït Bou Ichaouen (Talsint) carpet from the village of Anoual with an unusual pattern of unknown origin. Deep saturated magenta ground with a network of charcoal grey symbols shadowed in ivory. The fringe on is dyed with an ombre technique, blending from ivory to purple. There is some minor discoloration on one flat pile woven end, which does not detract from overall condition. 100% wool with a low twisted pile.
