A wonderful time worn Boujad creatively executed in a palette of abrashed reds, ranging from pink to deep terracotta, with accents of warm grey and orange punctuating the composition. An abstract Berber message of symbols includes distorted lozenges, ladder forms, agricultural motifs, effigies and other glyphs. Several areas of restoration are present, which do not detract from the overall quality or character of the piece. 100% wool with a densely knotted construction.
