A more recent very unique Boujad in terms of both pattern and color, with a strong urban influence. Vertical male sawtooth chain motifs dominate, with areas of open chessboards adding a graphic element to the composition. Other abstract agricultural forms appear near the bottom of the piece. Woven in a dense pile of faded purples and oranges with accents of jet black. Flat weave bands finish both ends. 100% wool.
