A unique time worn Boujad executed in a palette of plum, sky blue, steel grey, ivory and moss green. An abstract message of Berber symbols is created with geometric square and rectangular forms, and other glyphs vaguely resembling agricultural forms. Several areas of pile loss are present, which do not detract from the overall quality or character of this piece. 100% wool.
