A painterly boucherouite with an unusual deep abrashed ground of black, midnight blue and charcoal grey. A combination of female and male Berber symbolism includes abstract lozenge chains, V formations and bar motifs. The pattern is knotted in a multicolored palette of purple, green, coral red, orange, pink, sky blue, turquoise, pale yellow, and ivory. Woven with a combination of recycled cotton and mixed fibers.
