This vintage Boujad features an irregular lozenge network woven in an unusual palette of violet, faded lime green, grey, black, and ivory. The selvedges display the strongest moments of color, subtly dissipating at one end. Moments of the multicolored ground are visible, adding hints of additional color throughout. Wool pile knotted on a cotton warp and weft.
