This exceptional vintage Beni M'Guild features a large central lozenge motif with a network of squares and stepped motifs reverberating to the side borders of the carpet. Male square symbols are present throughout, lending a sense of movement to the piece. Bands of small triangle forms fill the borders. Wool dyed from natural sources in a palette of pomegranate, magenta, aubergine, brown, indigo, apricot, sable grey and ivory, with a striking color abrash in bands across the ground. 100% wool with a beautiful patina.
