A colorful example from the Aït Bou Ichaouen tribe. Horizontal bands of female lozenge motifs and male zig zag forms create a rhythm across the composition. The motif structure is knotted in a low pile of magenta, orange, coral red, pink, black and ivory, contrasting against the striped flat weave ground in coral, purple, olive green, and charcoal. 100% wool. This piece has been shortened from its original longer footprint, hence its very functional size.
