A time worn Boujad creatively woven in a palette of abrashed reds, ranging from faded pink to deep terra cotta, with accents of contrasting charcoal grey and ivory. An abstracted Berber story is narrated through symbols including floating lozenges, ladder forms, agricultural motifs, effigies and other glyphs. 100% wool with a low pile and finely knotted construction.
