An unusual flat weave piece from the Boujad region featuring an enigmatic large motif in vibrant orange that appears to emerge from the magenta field. Clusters of floating rod and V-formations are embroidered onto the surface creating a textural chainlike effect. The colorful palette also includes hints of turquoise, emerald, grey/blue, charcoal, and ivory. Woven in wool on a multicolored cotton warp.
