This vintage Moroccan Boujad is composed of a structured network of lozenges and double triangles executed in various color iterations. The symbols are organized within blocks, lending a strong sense of order to the piece. A border of smaller lozenge motifs frames the field. Woven in a unique palette of faded pink, salmon, lavender, celadon green, mint, brown, and ivory with a few unexpected dashes of fuchsia. 100% wool.
