This saturated Aït Youssi features bands of lozenge motifs, shifting from loose meandering chains to a tightly organized structure, then to a more erratic network. Larger scale partial lozenges at one end intermingle with primitively drawn human forms. Scarlet red dominates the field with accents in ivory, black, and lavender. Male zig zag protective symbols frame both selvedges. 100% wool.
