Woven with a low compact pile, this vintage Moroccan Beni M'Guild carpet has a diffuse lozenge network reminiscent of a bright red poppy field. Faded violet/grey and pale grey bands with hints of orange add depth and highlights, while the side ladder borders (symbolizing male protection) and charcoal selvages define the composition. Minor fringe loss. 100% wool.
