An intriguing vintage Beni M'Guild carpet displaying a classic stepped lozenge network curiously interrupted by a grouping of vertical rod formations. The layering creates a dynamic tension and synchrony, resulting in a very unique composition. Woven in a palette of natural dyes including pomegranate, magenta, aubergine, salmon, sable, blue-grey, ochre, and ivory, with a striking abrashed ground. Constructed of all wool with a beautiful patina.
