**This neutral older Azilal exhibits abstract meandering lozenge chains, distorted bar motifs, and scattered stones, lending to the primitive story of the piece. The motif system constructed of Berber knots in warm brown wool are variegated, creating a pixelated quality to the pattern. The fine ivory ground appears polished from age and use creating a lustrous patina. A few older repairs are evident along the selvages. 100% wool.**
