Full of character with its asymmetry and unusual proportions, this vintage Beni Ouarain carpet exemplifies the spirit of handcraft found in Berber arts. The large feminine central lozenge motifs are flanked by male branches forming protective borders. Finished with a band of checkerboards at one end. Knotted in dark brown and sable wool on a lustrous ivory ground, this piece has a lofty pile and very soft hand. 100% wool.
