This vintage Moroccan Aït Bou Ichaouen carpet exhibits a more traditional approach to works from this tribe. Vertical male sawtooth and motif chains accentuate the long and narrow proportions, likely woven for tent use. Finely woven in a dense low pile of charcoal grey, sea green, chartreuse, and bright orange on an abraded magenta ground. Flat weave bands finish both ends. A lovely find from the village of Talsint. 100% wool.
