A great example of an older Beni M'Guild carpet woven primarily with wool dyed from natural sources. A simplified Berber message is spoken, but an influence from the east is also evident. Palette includes faded plum, fig, truffle, salmon, lavender, and cognac. The colors have faded over time, providing a beautiful aged patina and depth to the piece. There are a few areas of restoration and some fringe loss, consistent for a carpet of this age. 100% wool.
