This Beni Ouarain exhibits a distorted lozenge network, shifting to a zig zag band at one end. The female fertility symbols create a symphony of patterns, with several moments gesturing to a human form. The composition is knotted in warm browns on an ivory/khaki ground. Some loss to the flat woven end is present, which does not detract from the overall condition or character of the piece. 100% wool with a time faded patina.
