A rare example of a Beni Ouarain with triangular formations combined to create an overall lozenge pattern. A sense of movement and layering is created by the alternating shifts in color and shading of the triangular forms throughout. Woven in an unusual color palette for this tribe: poppy red, celadon green and charcoal grey on an ivory ground. 100% wool with a time faded patina and lustrous hand, some fringe loss present.
