This vibrant example from the Boujad region is knotted in a palette of grass green, celadon green, orange, fluorescent pink, cobalt blue, coral, salmon, yellow and dark brown. A vertical chain of abstract lozenges dominates the center of the composition, with a confetti of brick forms scattered across the field. A single zig zag motif balances the male/female symbology in the piece. Woven with a combination of wool and recycled mixed fibers.
