**This Boucherouite runner features an array of open lozenges interspersed with partial diamonds, organized both loosely and in more structured vertical chains. Female V formations are present at the top of the piece, while male zig zag motifs frame the bottom. Knotted in a heathered brown ground with abraded pink, cobalt blue, salmon red, and peach composing the motif structure. Wool pile on a cotton warp with hints of multicolored Boucherouite throughout.**
