**This lively Boucherouite hanbel (flat weave) from the Middle Atlas region features a grid of pile raised slightly above the surface, overlaying the multicolored striped field. The palette of both the ground and pile features a broad spectrum of color. Woven in a combination of mixed wool and cotton fibers throughout, with minor fringe loss present.**
