An unusual small Moroccan Aït Bou Ichaouen featuring a chevron hamsa form dominating the top of the composition with lozenge chains and branch symbols near the bottom. A neutral warm ivory ground forms the foundation for the motifs knotted in medium to dark brown, dark navy, turquoise, mint green, and orange. A mixed construction of cotton and wool on a cotton warp.
