This vintage Moroccan Beni M'Guild features a graphic representation of common Berber lozenges, with linear motifs filling and connecting the forms. Male square forms are scattered throughout. Woven in a dense low pile in a palette of brick red, apricot, saffron yellow, and dark brown. A striking horizontal band of magenta remains, lending a painterly feel to the piece. Primarily wool with some cotton present.
