This Boujad features classic female symbolism combined with a colorful yet soft palette of orange, salmon, brick red, saffron yellow, faded purple, and ivory. A network of empty and filled lozenges in varying scale overlays an abrashed color field. Prominent bands of male rectangular forms provide several breaks in the motif structure, lending a more modern feel to the piece. 100% wool with a beautiful time faded patina.
