This carpet is the sibling to BG231, both sourced from one family and have remained together after all this time. Each piece exhibits a unique variation of a focused idea, with an artistic palette of salmon, violet, celadon green, turquoise and ivory emphasizing the weaver's creative approach. 100% wool.
