A vibrant example from the Aït Bou Ichaouen tribe in Eastern Morocco, this piece exudes joy and playfulness. A lozenge network comprised of alternating repeating checker forms creates a ribbon-like quality with a sense of movement. Carefully placed bird's eye motifs resemble flowers blossoming in a field. Knotted in purple, lime green, orange, yellow, turquoise, and pewter on a saturated magenta ground, a common color found in carpets from this region.
