A vintage carpet from the Guigou valley, a sub tribe of the Beni M'Guild, featuring a large scale ornate chevron pattern filled with Berber symbolism including lozenges, H-forms, triangles, and bars. The motifs appear etched into the abraded field, creating a sense of layering and depth. The striking palette includes scarlet red, orange, magenta, violet, indigo, dark brown, and faded sky blue. Asymmetrical side borders frame the piece. Note a few areas of repair are present. 100% wool with a dense pile and beautiful patina.
