A dynamic vintage Moroccan Boujad carpet featuring a central lozenge network that drifts from a tightly organized cluster to less constrained organic formations. Smaller diamonds are sprinkled throughout, highlighting the playful nature of the piece. Asymmetrical side borders composed of triangles and bars encroach on the central design as the composition appears to veer off course. Knotted with a fine lustrous wool in a palette of faded magenta, purple, lavender, dusty pink, charcoal, and pale celadon. All wool construction.
