A striking vintage Moroccan Aït Bou Ichaouen featuring an overall pattern of female fertility motifs. The forms are arranged into neatly organized bands, creating vertical chains that repeat over and over. The ground color shifts, with hues of saturated magenta and fire red lending depth and contrast throughout. Note the linear weighty selvedges framing the piece. All wool with a lustrous patina, c. 1960's. Generously scaled for everyday use.
