A dazzling vintage Moroccan Beni M'Guild featuring a densely organized network of intricate lozenges, triangles, chevrons, crosses, and branch motifs. An earthy ground of abraded plum and warm browns contrasts the richly decorated pattern in indigo, salmon pink, golden yellow, and ivory. Asymmetrically filled borders encase the field, holding a reinterpretation of the weaver's language. All wool with a lustrous hand and soft patina.
