SPRING PALETTE. This Beni M'Guild echoes a mountainous valley terrain flourishing with wild flowers. Bands of zig-zag formations reveal layers of patterns comprised of lozenges, squares, and hamsa motifs. A rhythmic symmetry fluctuates at one end, capturing an alternate glimpse of the same vista. Constructed of all wool in painterly hues of magenta, salmon, jade, periwinkle, violet, and ivory.
