This vintage Beni Ouarain exhibits a banded lozenge network filled with chessboard motifs, containing various Berber symbols including hamsa motifs, crosses, and stepped lozenges. Vertical lozenge chains along both selvages form protective borders. The pattern color shifts in bands across the composition, from grey to various shades of brown and faded black on an ivory ground. 100% wool.
