An excellent example vintage Chiadma carpet displaying a collage of Berber symbolism. Several vibrating lozenges are present throughout the composition, appearing to float over the background of motifs. Other classic Berber symbolism includes the eight pointed star, opened and closed lozenges, and diamond chains, while other non-traditional forms are also present. Knotted in an unusual palette of red-brown, faded lavender, warm apricot and smokey grey. 100% wool.
