This Azilal displays a colorful variation of the classic female lozenge network. The shifting of the pattern creates a dynamic composition in brightly colored cotton, including some fluorescent highlights. Motifs are knotted in a slightly higher pile than the ivory wool ground, adding dimension to the piece. Note the almost square proportions, making it a very functional piece. Woven on a cotton warp.
