A wonderful Rehamna with a composition of primarily male checkerboard and bar motifs shifting in color and placement across the field. An incomplete row of lozenges near the center of the carpet adds a female presence to the piece. The colors change in bands from faded pink to apricot, magenta to fuchsia, crimson to scarlet red. Hints of celadon green, orange, and lavender add highlights. Woven in wool with some natural dark brown goat hair in the warp and weft. Flat weave bands finish both ends.
